

(Welcome and Announcements is a time for hospitality and information dissemination)

#### CALL TO WORSHIP

### Charlie Maciorowski

(The Call to Worship is an invitation for the congregation to shift their attention from the distractions of daily life and focus hearts and minds on God. We are reminded that our worship centers on God and not on ourselves)

Liturgist: We gather together in the presence of God, our Shepherd, who calls us each by name, who restores our souls, who leads us in the way of righteousness, and whose goodness and love never stops pursuing us. This is the God we have come to worship!

All: We gather together to worship God, the Shepherd of our souls. The one who has created us, who sustains us, who redeems us, who walks beside us in good times and bad, and who calls us to follow. This is our God! Let's worship Him together!

## PRAYER OF CONFESSION

(The prayer of confession challenges us to reflect on our spiritual lives and work toward a Christ centered hope of reconciliation with God and our neighbors)

L: As we seek to embody God's love, we acknowledge the times we don't get it right. Trusting in God's promise to be with us, let us join in the prayer of confession followed by a time of silent confession...

All: Merciful God, we confess that we have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone. We have not loved You with our whole heart and mind and strength. We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. In your mercy forgive what we have been, help us amend what we are, and direct what we shall be, so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways, to the glory of Your Holy Name.

(Time for Silent Confession)

(This time provides us with an opportunity of personal reflection, allowing individuals to connect with the prayer on a deeper level.)

#### \*ASSURANCE OF PARDON

(The assurance of pardon is a declaration of God's forgiveness and bountiful mercy on God's children)

Friends, our Lord Jesus Christ personally carried our sins in his body on the cross so that we can be dead to sin and live for what is right. By His wounds you are healed! Once you were like sheep who wandered away. But now you have returned to your Shepherd, the Guardian of your souls. Friends, believe the Good News of the Gospel. In Jesus Christ, we are forgiven!

All: Thanks be to God. Amen
